## **TARIFF 13**

### **MOBILE DJ**

Tariff for the communicating to the public of sound recordings

Effective from: 1 January 2019 to 31 December 2019.

1. The communicating of sound recordings to the public is a restricted act in terms of the South African Copyright Act and requires a licence from SAMPRA for the use of sound recordings in its **repertoire**. This document sets out SAMPRA's tariff for the communicating to the public of sound recordings as **Featured Music** by **DJ'S WHO REQUIRE THEIR OWN LICENCE TO COVER INDIVIDUAL, AND ONE OFF EVENTS**; examples include Fetes, Outdoor Shows, Sports Club Discos, Local Business' Christmas parties, 21st Birthday Parties, Weddings etc.
2. This tariff is subject to SAMPRA's "General Terms and Conditions for Communicating Sound Recordings to the Public Licences", a copy of which can be accessed on SAMPRA's website or obtained by contacting SAMPRA.
3. The mobile DJ licence does not cover the following:
  - 3.1 Events held in discotheques, nightclubs or similar venues;
  - 3.2 Permanent/regular engagements;
  - 3.3 Consecutive events held in the same venue.

With regards to 1, 2 and 3 above, further information can be provided to SAMPRA so that the necessary licences can be arranged for the individual promoters or venues.

4. Penalty Clause – You should obtain your SAMPRA licence before you can publicly communicate sound recordings. If you continue with the communicating to the public without first obtaining or renewing your licence, a surcharge can be added to this tariff. This is designed to act as a deterrent to unlicensed communications to the public of sound recordings.
5. Fees:

FLAT FEE: R2,246.97 per annum per DJ (exclusive of VAT).

VAT should be added at the current rate to the above charges.

6. DEFINITIONS:

**"Repertoire"** means the collection of copyright sound recordings owned or controlled by members of SAMPRA from time to time.

**"Featured Music"**. The playing of sound recordings as a main or special attraction that is essential to the operation of the premises and/or the main event.
