BACKGROUND MUSIC – CARAVAN PARKS & CAMPING SITES

Tariff for the communicating to the public of sound recordings

Effective from: 1 January 2020 to 31 December 2020.

1. The communicating of sound recordings to the public is a restricted act in terms of the South African Copyright Act (Act 98 of 1978, as amended) and Performers Protection Act (11 of 1967, as amended) and requires a licence from SAMPRA for the use of sound recordings in its **repertoire**. This document sets out SAMPRA's tariff for the communicating to the public of sound recordings in **CARAVAN PARKS AND CAMPING SITES**.
2. This tariff is subject to SAMPRA's "General Terms and Conditions for Communicating Sound Recordings to the Public Licences", a copy of which can be accessed on SAMPRA's website (<http://www.sampra.org.za>) or obtained by contacting SAMPRA (see contact details here above).
3. This tariff applies to the communicating to the public of sound recordings in caravan parks and camping sites as **background music**. There are specific types of communicating sound recordings to the public that SAMPRA does not classify as **background music** and which are licensed under separate tariffs.
4. Examples of use covered by this tariff include aerobics & dance instruction, background music in bars, restaurants, shops, boutiques, games arcades, fairground rides, swimming pools, cinemas, video rooms, waiting rooms and reception areas within Caravan Parks. Discotheques, dances, DJ presentations, concerts and music festivals are to be charged separately, using the relevant tariff.
5. Penalty Clause – A SAMPRA licence should be obtained before sound recordings are publicly communicated. Should sound recordings be communicated to the public without first obtaining or renewing a licence, a surcharge can be added to this tariff. This is designed to act as a deterrent to unlicensed communications to the public of sound recordings.
6. The Licence Fees payable under this tariff are set out in the table below:

Number Of Caravans And Tents	Annual Fee
1 – 100	R 1 371.28
101 – 200	R 2 009.93
201 – 300	R 2 648.58
301 – 400	R 3 287.23
401 – 500	R 3 925.88

Fees increase at R638.65 per 100 caravans or tents within a park/campsite or part thereof.

This tariff is subject to a minimum fee of **R1,371.28** per annum.

VAT will be added to the fee at the current rate.

7. DEFINITIONS:

“Background Music” means the playing of recorded music to create an atmosphere or ambience that is not a special feature of, or essential to, the main event or is not essential to the operation of the premises.

“Repertoire” means the collection of copyright sound recordings owned or controlled by members of SAMPRA from time to time.
